



**Cummins/McCollum
15-acre Easement with two 4-acre easements added in 2011
Reily Township, Butler County**

The 15-acre conservation easement permanently protects open space, scenic vistas, and natural environmental systems. Many species of wildlife utilize the property, which boasts a remarkably diversity of habitats, including upland and riparian woodlands, open areas, and ponds. The site also features native grasslands and wetlands, developed with assistance from U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and Miami Valley Pheasants Forever, that are heavily used by both resident and migratory wildlife.
