Anne Geddes donated the easement on this 88-acre parcel in Reily Township, Butler County as part of a planned larger preserve with adjacent property. The property is situated between two existing Butler County MetroPark preserves and includes nearly one mile of riparian corridor along Indian Creek including a dramatic 130 ft. embankment.

This working farm has a long history starting with native American settlements and followed by construction of one of the earliest sawmills, which supplied logs for local cabins. The first white child buried in Reily Township was buried on this farm in 1803. It has been a working farm since then with and will eventually be converted to prairie, forest and wetlands. The property provides habitat for beaver, mink, fox, pileated and red-headed woodpeckers.
