Jerry and Cleo Gerber have protected an additional 395 acres of their property in Preble County through the bargain sale of an agricultural conservation easement funded by the Ohio Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Easement Purchase Program.

This primarily agricultural land is used for row crops and pasture. The Gerbers practice no-till farming, use cover crops, fence cattle away from the creek and have installed grassed waterways.

The Gerbers received the Conservation Farm of the Year Award in 1999 and the Conservation Good Science Award in 1998.
