The Puffs have lived on their land there for 49 years, and the Wildflower Sanctuary has been a part of their lives and their children's lives. One of the driving reasons for the Puff's easement was to honor their son, Frederick Wilson Puff, who grew up playing and exploring in the Sanctuary. The Puff Easement is the third completed easement of the proposed conservation easements laid out in the original Silvoor Lane agreements with the Trust from the late 1990s. The Puffs now have joined John and Phyllis Blocher and Todd Hollenbaugh in protecting the beautiful wildflower sanctuary created by Dr. Heffner beginning in the 1930s, and still flourishing today.
